LOT - .999 Fine Silver Walking Liberty Round



Description

- Contains 1/10 Troy oz of .999 pure silver.
- Features Lady Liberty on the obverse.
- Displays an American bald eagle on the reverse.

The Walking Liberty design, introduced in 1916 and created by Adolph A. Weinman, was one of two designs submitted to the United States Mint that year. Ultimately, both of his designs were selected for different denominations.

This iconic image originally appeared on the US Half Dollar from 1916 to 1947. It was later reintroduced in 1986 on the American Silver Eagle bullion coin, where it still graces the obverse today.

On the obverse of these 1/10 oz Walking Liberty Silver Rounds, Lady Liberty is depicted in left-profile relief, draped in the American flag. The background shows Liberty walking toward the rising sun, holding oak and laurel branches in her left hand.

The reverse of the SilverTowne Walking Liberty Silver Rounds features an American bald eagle in left-profile relief, perched on an olive branch with its wings raised.
